

General information 1st – 6th year of study

- PE is optional for all the students of 3rd FM
- 3 credits for each item (Physical Training 1-6, a semestral course, week-long courses)
 - Possibility to enrol in any of them repeatedly each year of study
- Requirements for completing optional subject PT 1-6:
 - Active participation
 - Minimum 12 times attendance per academic year
- Other smestral courses are set according to the lecturer (info in SIS)





- usually on weekends type B courses














VSK Medik Club
